Mentored Leadership Development Program

Online Live | Over 6 Months | 6x 1-2 Hr Monthly Mentorship Sessions

Focused on enabling leaders to drive a measurable enhancement in their leadership performance through tailored mentorship and industry-led content. The Mentored Leadership Development (MLD) program leverages the success of the IOLM group-based mentorship program, using a 5:1 ratio between mentor and mentees over six months, to enhance critical leadership skills tailored to each participant's specific challenges.

This program is designed for new or experienced leaders seeking to enhance their leadership performance, and engagement between key stakeholders within their organizations.

Overview

Participants will complete 6 x 1-2 hour group-mentorship sessions over 6 months - completing a tailored leadership development plan to best meet specific participant leadership challenges. Leadership performance is assessed through 3 x 360 assessments conducted with participant stakeholders within their organization over the 6-month program.

Participants will also gain insight into key prevalent leadership topics, including critical communication skills, adaptive leadership, the Cynefin decision-making framework, design thinking, group-based decision-making, mentorship & coaching through 6 hours of asynchronous micro lessons (20 min each). To enable flexibility, the 6 - hours of asynchronous lessons are consumable at the convenience of the participant's schedules over the 6-month program.

Learning Objectives

- Derive a measurable leadership performance improvement as assessed by the participants' stakeholders.
- Grow individual networks by attending quarterly tailored live networking events.
- Gain an understanding of the Industry 4.0 leadership styles.
- Understand your current leadership profile, individual skill gaps and development opportunities.
- Complete a self-assessment identifying personal mentorship-specific skills gaps.
- Improve context awareness of key leadership challenges & solutions through group mentee interactions.
- Gain an understanding of the roles of mentorship and coaching.
- Understand how to execute and lead a mentored leadership development program within a team.
- · Develop critical interpersonal skills.
- Understand the evolving practice of Adaptive Leadership.
- Gain insight into decision-making approaches such as the Cynefin framework, Design thinking and Nominal group-based techniques.
- Participants will as well receive an additional tools & resources package to enable sustained performance growth post the program.
